	<p><b><u>11 and Under 200 m Open Water Event:</u></b></p> <p>This is a Mini Open Water Event for our younger swimmers to participate in and gain experience in an Open Water event.</p> <p>Swimmers will start from the walkway (marked on Map in yellow) and swim around the marker buoys (marked on map in red), following the course marked in Green, finishing at the beach (marked on map in blue).</p> <p>Swimmers who are 8 years and younger must swim with a chaperone to compete in this event which will be run prior to the other listed distance events. Both swimmer and chaperone must wear the same coloured swim cap which may be a</p>			

	<p>Swimming Club cap. Parents and Siblings aged 14 years and over are eligible to act as chaperones for this event only.</p> <p><u>To nominate your chaperone if you are entering the 11 years and under 200 m event and are aged 8 years and younger, please use the QR Code and complete the form by the 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025. Swimmers who have not completed this form will not be eligible to swim.</u></p> 
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<p>SNT Competitive Member, Masters Member, Interstate Members (Swim Central) \$11.00 incl GST + associated Swim Central Fees.</p> <p>Non- Members: \$11.00 incl GST event entry + associated Swim Central Fees. Non-members must purchase a "2025 SNT Open Water Swimmer ONLY Membership" for the "Open Water Season" prior to entering the event, which includes all 4 Swimming NT Open Water Events and Insurances.</p>

<b>Rules</b>	<p>All Events will be conducted under Swimming Australia Competition and Swimming Australia Open Water Rules.</p> <p>Swimmers competing in the 11yrs and Under 200 meter event will compete under the above mentioned rules and NT Swimming Open Water Rules. All swimmers will complete the course in a sportsmanship and respectful way.</p>
<b>Swim Caps</b>	<p>All swimmers must wear a swim cap during this event and are welcome to wear their Swimming Club Caps or another Swimming Cap. Swimming NT will not be providing Swim Caps for this Open Water Event. However, if you have forgotten your cap we will have a variety of caps for sale that can be purchased for \$5.00.</p>
