

















SNT Junior Development Team Gold Coast Camp

Selection Criteria

Competition	2025 Somerset Dual Meet & 2025 SGC Sprint Championships
	18 th January & 25 th January 2025
Selection	Swimmers will be selected based on performances from 1st January 2024 through to 2 nd November 2024.
	Swimmers will be notified of their team selection by Friday 8 th November 2024.
Eligibility	To be considered for selection:
	The swimmer must be available to fulfil all team commitments, listed below.
	The swimmer must have competed in either (2) of the following events:
	 2024 NT Swimming Championships 2024 NT SC Championships 2024 Country Swimming Championships
	Minimum age is 12yrs, as of 25 th January 2025.
	Maximum age is 20yrs, as of 25 th January 2025.
	The swimmer must have met the Qualifying Times for the 2025 SGC Sprint Championships in a minimum of 3 events (Events on offer include only all 50m events).
	Swimmers' that have been selected on any Australian Senior or Junior Team or any touring NT Team, not including School Sports Teams, are ineligible for selection.
	Swimmers that represent another federation, state association or do not hold a valid 2024-25 Season Membership are ineligible for selection.
	Swimmers that are current members of either the SNT Youth Performance Program, or SNT Emerging Talent Program will be given first preference.
	All swimmers MUST meet a minimum of 2000 points in their best 5 events throughout the qualifying period, outlined above, utilising the Hy-tek Single year points system.
Team Size	24 swimmers, 1 Female coach and 1 Male coach, 1 Female Team Manager and 1 Male Team Manager, 1 Technical Official / Team Manager. Current Ochre Cards must be held by all Coaches and Team Managers.













	All team selected swimmers MUST be available for the following dates:
	 Travel Dates – 17th January – 25th January 2025 Team Bonding and Briefing day – 23rd November 2024 at the 2pm prior to the Casuarina Invitational – details to be provided closer to the date.
	All participants MUST:
Team Commitments	 Comply with the SNT Code of Conduct. Complete the SNT Team Code of Conduct. Complete the SNT Travel Waiver. Swimmers must have a high level of fitness to travel with the SNT team. If a swimmer is injured or has a prolonged illness between team selection and the departure date, they and their coach must notify SNT immediately. If it is of the view of the SNT executive and Board that an athlete is not in peak condition, they may be deselected from the team.
	SNT funds all development activities held within the Northern Territory, however due to the cost of this trip, a swimmer contribution will be required. Selected swimmers must contribute \$1,100.00 to help meet costs. (Depending on final costings, this fee may be lower – but NOT
Fees	higher)
	A deposit of \$400.00 is due by Friday 29 th November 2024.
	A second payment of \$350.00 is due by Friday 20 th December 2024.
	A final payment of \$350.00 is due by Friday 10 th January 2025.
Events	SNT will discuss event entries with each swimmer's coach and will fund up to 5 entries per swimmer for the Somerset Dual Meet and 4 entries for the SGC Sprint Championships.
Coaches	SNT have selected coaches based on assistance within the region at recent development activities, as well as coaches that will gain important experience and exposure to assist their squads and clubs. The coaches selected by SNT will be announced shortly.
	The team selection for this development opportunity will be determined by:
	SNT Selection Committee, if formed, or SNT Executive Management.
	The team selection consideration includes:
	The restriction of a maximum of 13 swimmers per gender.
	The swimmers' performances in individual strokes.
Team Selection	 The best needs of the team in specific strokes/events. Consideration of the performance development requirements of the athlete.
- realiti Sciection	 Determination of the swimmers' adherence to the SNT Code of Conduct throughout
	the year.
	 First preference will be open to current SNT Performance Pathway Squad members. The remainder of the team will be made from SNT Youth Performance Squad Members that have achieved the highest combined point score from their top five events as per the single year Hy-Tek point Score. NOTE: Regional-based swimmers will have their points boosted by 10% due to the reduced access to competition.
Note	SNT may amend these selection criteria at any time at its discretion and can make any necessary changes to the team, where required.
