



Head Coach – Casuarina Swimming Club

Description – Casuarina Swimming Club is located in the northern suburbs' growth area of Darwin, Northern Territory. With a tropical climate, the location is a gateway to south east Asia and beyond with established competitions and links. The Casuarina Aquatic Centre will be undergoing an extensive \$25 million upgrade of the facility in the latter half of 2021, making this is an ideal opportunity for an experienced coach to re-locate to a COVID-free community, with increased access to lane usage for training, club nights and competition.

The Club is seeking a self-employed/independent contractor ASCTA Advanced/Silver accredited swimming coach to commence asap. The business will run alongside the Casuarina Storm Swimming Club, hence the ability to work with Club Management Committee is essential. The Club currently has a squad of around 100 swimmers, including 72 who are registered competitive swimmers, with potential to increase these numbers. Swimmers range from beginners to Australian Age National qualifiers.

Roles/Responsibilities - The successful coach, will continue to establish strong development pathways for all swimmers and in this role will have the following responsibilities:

- Work with the Coaching team, Committee, and whole Club to establish an environment that fosters positive team and sporting attitudes, as well as responsibility, and the promotion of self-discipline.
- Assist with overseeing all squad levels offered by the Club.
- Act as a mentor for all swimmers and assistant coaches, and assist with squad selection/ promotion.
- Participate in coaching team meetings, liaise closely with your coaching team on training and swimmer development, individual and group training programs, including the development of the seasonal CSC training plan and calendar.
- Have knowledge of Swimming Australia, Swimming Northern Territory, and Casuarina Swimming Club policies (e.g. Safe Sports Framework, Complaints Management, Code of Conduct), and ensure that your behaviour reflects these policies.
- Attend home and away swim meets, providing support and feedback to swimmers, and attend swim camps as required.
- Contribute to the cost of lane hire as negotiated with Committee

- Current Advanced (Silver) Level Licence coaching accreditation
- Current ASCTA Membership and insurance
- Current First Aid/ CPR certificates
- Current Working with Children Check
- be eligible to work in Australia for the duration of the appointment.
